Dear Mayor Bailey:

On April 7, 2004, my son, Capt. Brent Morel, USMC, was killed in action in Iraq. Not long after losing Brent, I joined the American Gold Star Mothers Inc., Department of Tennessee. Joining with other moms who experienced the loss of a child serving in the military, we fulfill the mission statement of our organization: honoring our children through service to Veterans and Military Families. We are always seeking ways to educate the public about Gold Star Families and to keep the sacrifices of our loved ones from being forgotten.

Last year, we sent a letter to Governor Haslam requesting that TN honor and remember men and women who have died while in military service to our country. We suggested designating a major highway that crosses the state be named in honor of our heroes. We feel it is important that the highway cross the state rather than be located in one region. Gov. Haslam suggested we write our State Senators and Representatives with our request. Currently Gold Star Mothers across the state are sending out letters to their respective County Mayors, Representatives and Senators.

Our request has been heard, and Bill Sanderson, Representative from District 77 has agreed to Sponsor our resolution. Many other legislators from across the state have agreed to sign-on as co-sponsors and to vote in favor of the resolution. Recently we met with Bill, and agreed that we would like the designated highway to be State Route 1, which brings me to the point of this letter.

This highway crosses 23 counties in the state of Tennessee, including Hawkins. We would like for each of these 23 counties to adopt the attached resolution so the signs can be placed at the entrance and exit of your county along State Route 1. The approximate cost to your county will be \$162.50 each for two signs. The signs will state the following: "Gold Star Families Highway-Honoring our Fallen Heroes". TDOT for your region would install the signs in the appropriate location along State Route 1.

Once your county has passed the Resolution, we need you to contact the State Representatives for your region to let them know you passed the resolution and Representative Bill Sanderson's office. This is a joint venture of all the counties involved, and I know the Gold Star Families in your county will appreciate your participation.

We would be happy to work with you on this project in any way necessary. Other states have designated highways in this manner and we feel it would be wonderful way to

educate the public and to let people who travel across the Volunteer State know that we support and honor our Heroes from all generations.

# CODE OF ETHICS

## HAWKINS COUNTY, TENNESSEE

Adopted March 26, 2007

Resolution 2007/03/03

Amended March 24, 2014

### **Section 1. Definitions.**

- (1) "County" means Hawkins County, which includes all boards, committees, commissions, authorities, corporations or other instrumentalities appointed or created by the county or an official of the county, and specifically including the county school board, the county election commission, the county health department, and utility districts in the county.
- (2) "Officials and employees" means and includes any official, whether elected or appointed, officer, employee or servant, or any member of any board, agency, commission, authority or corporation (whether compensated or not), or any officer, employee or servant thereof, of the county.
- (3) "Personal interest" means, for the purpose of disclosure of personal interests in accordance with this Code of Ethics, a financial interest of the official or employee, or a financial interest of the official's or employee's spouse or child living in the same household, in the matter to be voted upon, regulated, supervised, or otherwise acted upon in an official capacity.

### **Section 2. Disclosure of personal interest in voting matters.**

An official or employee with the responsibility to vote on a measure shall disclose during the meeting at which the vote takes place, before the vote and to be included in the minutes, any personal interest that affects or that would lead a reasonable person to infer that it affects the official's or employee's vote on the measure. In addition, the official or employee may, to the extent allowed by law, recuse himself or herself from voting on the measure.

### **Section 3. Disclosure of personal interest in non-voting matters.**

An official or employee who must exercise discretion relative to any matter other than casting a vote, and who has a personal interest in the matter that affects or that would lead a reasonable person to infer that it affects the exercise of the discretion shall disclose, before the exercise of the discretion when possible, the interest on the attached disclosure form (Attachment I - Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement) and file the disclosure form in the *County Mayor's office with Alana M. Roberts, or in her absence with Amanda Burton*. In addition, the official or employee may, to the extent allowed by law, recuse himself or herself from the exercise of discretion in the matter.

#### **Section 4. Acceptance of gifts and other things of value.**

An official or employee, or an official's or employee's spouse or child living in the same household, may not accept, directly or indirectly, any gift, money, gratuity, or other consideration or favor of any kind from anyone other than the county:

- (1) For the performance of an act, or refraining from performance of an act, that he would be expected to perform, or refrain from performing, in the regular course of his duties; or
- (2) That a reasonable person would understand was intended to influence the vote, official action, or judgment of the official or employee in executing county business.

It shall not be considered a violation of this policy for an official or employee to receive entertainment, food, refreshments, meals, health screenings, amenities, foodstuffs, or beverages that are provided in connection with a conference sponsored by an established or recognized statewide association of county government officials or by an umbrella or affiliate organization of such statewide association of county government officials.

#### **Section 5. Ethics Complaints.**

- 5.1 A County Ethics Committee (the "Ethics Committee") consisting of five members shall be appointed to one-year terms by the County Mayor with confirmation by the county legislative body, to be appointed each year at the same time as internal committees of the county legislative body. At least three members of the committee shall be members of the county legislative body; one member shall be a constitutional county officer or, should no constitutional county officer be willing to accept appointment, an additional member of the county legislative body; and the remaining member may be either a member of a board, committee, commission, authority, corporation, or other instrumentality governed by this policy, or an additional member of the county legislative body. The Ethics Committee shall convene as soon as practicable after their appointment and elect a chair, a co-chair, and a secretary. The records of the Ethics Committee shall be maintained by the secretary and shall be filed in the office of the County Mayor and in the office of the County Clerk, where they shall be open to public inspection.
- 5.2 Questions and complaints regarding violations of this Code of Ethics or of any violation of state law governing ethical conduct should be directed to the chair of the Ethics Committee. Complaints shall be in writing and signed by the person making the complaint, and shall set forth in reasonable detail the facts upon which the complaint is based. (Attachment II – Complaint Form approved by Co Comm. ).
- 5.3 *Upon receipt of a complaint, the committee chair shall provide each member of the Ethics Committee and the County Attorney with a copy of the complaint for review.*
- 5.4 *The committee chair shall then schedule an executive session with the County Attorney to discuss the issue. The item shall be considered at the next Ethics Committee meeting.*
- 5.5 *If no action is warranted, the complaint shall be kept on file in the office of the County Mayor for a period of five (5) years, clearly marked "NO ACTION TAKEN". Both parties shall be notified of the decision in writing.*



- 5.6 *If the complaint is to go forward to investigation, with possible action to be taken, the chair shall schedule a meeting with the Ethics Committee. The person who filed the complaint and the person named in the complaint shall be notified in writing of the date, time and place of the meeting. Neither party shall be required to attend this meeting.*
- 5.7 *The County Ethics Committee shall investigate any credible complaint against an official or employee charging any violation of this Code of Ethics, will undertake an investigation on its own initiative when it acquires information indicating a possible violation, and make recommendations for action to end or seek retribution for any activity that, in the Committee's judgment, constitutes a violation of this Code of Ethics. If a member of the Committee is the subject of a complaint, such member shall recuse himself or herself from all proceedings involving such complaint.*
- 5.8 *All Ethics Committee meetings will be voice recorded. A digital copy of the recording will be maintained in the County Mayor's office and a CD copy will be filed with the minutes.*
- 5.9 *Ethics complaint forms shall be picked up in the County Mayor's office from Alana M. Roberts, or in her absence from Amanda Burton, or in the office of the County Clerk.*
- 5.10 *The completed complaint form must be notarized by a certified notary public. The notary public should not be a staff member from an elected official's office to avoid conflict of interest.*
- 5.11 *All complaints shall be filed in the County Mayor's office with Alana M. Roberts, or in her absence with Amanda Burton. The date the complaint was received will be written on the complaint form and the committee chairman notified.*
- 5.12 *The minutes of the Ethics Committee shall be provided to Alana M. Roberts in the County Mayor's office for filing and distribution to the Ethics Committee members.*
- 5.13 *The Chairman of the Ethics Committee shall notify the complainant and the alleged violator of the committee's decision in writing.*

The Committee may:

- (1) Refer the matter to the County Attorney for a legal opinion and/or recommendations for action;
- (2) In the case of an official, refer the matter to the county legislative body for possible public censure if the county legislative body finds such action warranted;
- (3) In the case of an employee, refer the matter to the official responsible for supervision of the employee for possible disciplinary action if the official finds discipline warranted;
- (4) In a case involving possible violation of state statutes, refer the matter to the district attorney for possible ouster or criminal prosecution;

The interpretation that a reasonable person in the circumstances would apply shall be used in interpreting and enforcing this Code of Ethics. When a violation of this Code of Ethics also constitutes a violation of a personnel policy or a civil service policy, the violation shall be dealt with as a violation of the personnel or civil service provisions rather than as a violation of this Code of Ethics.

## **Section 6. Applicable State Laws.**

In addition to the ethical principles set out in this Code of Ethics, state laws also provide a framework for the ethical behavior of county officials and employees in the performance of their duties. Officials and employees should familiarize themselves with the state laws applicable to their office or position and the performance of their duties. To the extent that an issue is addressed by state law (law of general application, public law of local application, local option law, or private act), the provisions of that state law, to the extent they are more restrictive, shall control. Following is a brief summary of selected state laws concerning ethics in county government. For the full text of these statutes, see the Tennessee Code Annotated (T.C.A.) sections indicated.

**Campaign Finance**—T.C.A. Title 2, Chapter 10. Part One (campaign financial disclosure) requires candidates for public office to disclose contributions and contributors to their campaigns. Part Three (campaign contribution limits) limits the total amount of campaign contributions a candidate may receive from an individual and sets limits on the amount a candidate may receive in cash.

**Conflict of Interest**—T.C.A. § 12-4-101 is the general conflict of interest statute that applies in all counties. It prohibits anyone who votes for, lets out, or in any manner supervises any work or contract from having a direct financial interest in that contract, purchase or work, and it requires disclosure of indirect financial interests by public acknowledgment.

**Conflict of Interest**—T.C.A. § 49-6-2003 applies to the department of education in all counties and prohibits direct and indirect conflicts of interest in the sale of supplies for use in public schools.

**Conflict of Interest**—T.C.A. § 5-1-125 applies in all counties and prohibits county officials and employees from purchasing surplus county property except where it is sold by public bid.

**Conflict of Interest**—T.C.A. § 54-7-203 applies in all counties that are governed by the County Uniform Highway Law. It prohibits officials and employees in the highway department and members of the county legislative body from having any personal interest in purchases of supplies, materials, machinery, and equipment for the highway department.

**Conflict of Interest**—T.C.A. § 5-14-114 applies in counties that have adopted the County Purchasing Law of 1957. It prohibits the purchasing agent, members of the purchasing commission, and all county officials from having any financial or other personal beneficial interest in any contract or purchase of goods or services for any department or agency of the county.

**Conflict of Interest**—T.C.A. § 5-21-121 applies in counties that have adopted the County Financial Management System of 1981. It prohibits all county officials and employees from having any financial or other personal beneficial interest in the purchase of any supplies, materials or equipment for the county.

**Conflict of Interest**—T.C.A. §§ 5-5-102 and 12-4-101 govern disclosures and abstentions from voting due to conflicts of interest of members of county legislative bodies.

**Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statements**—T.C.A. § 8-50-501 and the following sections require candidates and appointees to local public offices to file a disclosure statement with the state ethics commission listing major sources of income, investments, lobbying activities, professional services provided, bankruptcies, certain loans, and other information, and to keep these statements up to date.

**Gifts**—T.C.A. § 5-14-114 applies in counties that have adopted the County Purchasing Law of 1957. It prohibits the purchasing agent, members of the purchasing commission, and all county officials from receiving anything of value, directly or indirectly, from anyone who may have or obtain a contract or purchase order with the county.

**Gifts**—T.C.A. § 5-21-121 applies in counties that have adopted the County Financial Management System of 1981. It prohibits the finance director, purchasing agent, and employees in those departments from accepting anything of value, directly or indirectly, from anyone who furnishes supplies, materials or equipment to the county.

**Honoraria**—T.C.A. § 2-10-116 prohibits elected officials from accepting an honorarium (including money or anything of value, but not including reimbursement for actual expenses) for an appearance, speech, or article in their official capacity.

**Private Use of Public Property**—T.C.A. § 54-7-202 applies in counties that are governed by the County Uniform Highway Law. It prohibits the private use of equipment, rock, and other highway materials.

**Court Sales**—T.C.A. § 39-16-405 prohibits judges, clerks of court, court officers, and employees of court, from bidding on or purchasing any property sold through the court for which such person discharges official duties.

**Rules of the Supreme Court**—Rule 10, Cannon 5 (Code of Judicial Conduct) establishes ethical rules for judges and other court personnel when exercising judicial functions.

**Fee Statutes**—T.C.A. §§ 8-21-101, 8-21-102, and 8-21-103 set out circumstances where fees are authorized, prohibit officials from requiring payment of fees in advance of performance of services except where specifically authorized, and set penalties for charging excessive or unauthorized fees.

**Consulting Fee Prohibition for Elected County Officials**—T.C.A. §§ 2-10-122 and 2-10-124 prohibit officials from receiving compensation for advising or assisting a person or entity in influencing county legislative or administrative action.

**Crimes Involving Public Officials**—T.C.A. § 39-16-101 and the following sections prohibit bribery, soliciting unlawful compensation, and buying and selling in regard to offices.

**Official Misconduct**—T.C.A. § 39-16-402 applies to public servants and candidates for office and prohibits unauthorized exercise of official power, acting in an official capacity exceeding the servant's power, refusal to perform a duty imposed by law, violating a law relating to the servant's office or employment, and receiving a benefit not provided by law.

**Official Oppression**—T.C.A. § 39-16-403 prohibits abuse of power by a public servant.

**Bribery for Votes**—T.C.A. §§ 2-19-121, 2-19-126, and 2-19-127 prohibit bribery of voters in elections.

**Misuse of Official Information**—T.C.A. § 39-16-404 prohibits a public servant from attaining a benefit or aiding another person in attaining a benefit from information which was obtained in an official capacity and is not available to the public.

**Ouster Law**—T.C.A. § 8-47-101 sets out conduct that is punishable by ouster from office, including misconduct in office and neglect of duty.

**RESOLUTION IN REF:                SUPPORT OF THE HOUSE BILL 1565 and SENATE BILL 1791 WHICH CALLS FOR RESTRICTING PSEUDOEPHEDRINE PRODUCT SALES/DISTRIBUTION IN THE STATE OF TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of the County of Hawkins, Tennessee, recognize that the clandestine manufacture of the illegal drug methamphetamine has become a scourge on our community; and

WHEREAS, persons engaged in clandestine methamphetamine manufacture and use routinely endanger innocent children, their neighbors, and innocent citizens, health care and pharmaceutical workers; and

WHEREAS, Hawkins County, Tennessee, has witnessed violent crime committed by persons addicted to methamphetamine use; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee generally and the county of Hawkins have become known to drug enforcement officials for the high incidence of illicit manufacture, sale and use of methamphetamine; and

WHEREAS, millions of tax payers funds have been spent annually in the State of Tennessee for the cleanup of methamphetamine labs, foster care, and providing medical care; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee comptroller of treasury reports that from 2007 to 2011, the State of Tennessee has spent \$70,000,000, (seventy million dollars) annually; and

WHEREAS, the cities that had passed local ordinances restricting the sale of ephedrine/pseudoephedrine by prescription only in 2013, experienced a 44% to 70% reduction in the production of methamphetamine; and

WHEREAS, the prestigious Vanderbilt University conducted a non-partisan independent poll of likely voters showing a 65% support for statewide prescription legislation reaffirms the fact that approximately 85% of Tennesseans DO NOT purchase cold and allergy products containing ephedrine/ pseudoephedrine; and

WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi passed legislation in 2010, making ephedrine/ pseudoephedrine a scheduled drug sold by prescription only and in the first year of implementation realized a 67% reduction in meth production and 82% drop in children from meth labs being placed into foster care; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and County Commissioners for Hawkins County, Tennessee, do believe, hereby find, and determine that requiring a prescription for the sale of ephedrine or pseudoephedrine will assist Hawkins County in its efforts to combat the criminal activity associated with the illegal manufacture of methamphetamine in said county, and will not unduly restrict legitimate businesses or customers from selling and buying these products.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Commissioners of Hawkins County, Tennessee that Hawkins County, Tennessee, supports the legislation filed as HB#1565 or, in the alternative, requests the State of Tennessee to write into law that it shall be illegal to sell, deliver, or distribute ephedrine,



pseudoephedrine, their salts, their optical isomers or salts of their optical isomers, without a valid prescription from a physician, pharmacist, or other licensed healthcare professional licensed by the State of Tennessee to write prescriptions and filled by a Tennessee licensed pharmacist.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a copy of this resolution be sent to our Tennessee State Representative and Senator representing Hawkins County, Tennessee.

RESOLUTION IN REF: AMENDMENT TO CLARIFY WORDING IN ATTACHED RES 2014/02/01 IN REFERENCE TO SECTION 2 OF THE RESOLUTION REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MEMBERS FOR AN AUDIT COMMITTEE FOR HAWKINS COUNTY

WHEREAS, Hawkins County Commission Resolution 2014/02/01 gave approval to establish an Audit Committee for Hawkins County; and,

WHEREAS, an amendment was made to remove the wording that the committee will consist of 3 county commissioners from the budget committee and replace it to state that 7 county commissioners, 1 from each district will be placed on the committee; and,

WHEREAS, due to the time constraints related to establishing the Audit Committee, the amendment was withdrawn until the next county commission meeting; and,

**RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH AN AUDIT COMMITTEE  
FOR HAWKINS COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, *Tennessee Code Annotated* (T.C.A.) Section 9-3-405, encourages county governments to establish an independent Audit Committee, and provides that the Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury (Comptroller) may require an Audit Committee in counties that (1) are in noncompliance with the accounting and financial reporting standards required by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board or (2) have recurring findings from the annual audit for three or more consecutive years that are determined by the Comptroller's office to be a material weakness in internal control or material noncompliance with government auditing standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Comptroller and the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada recommends that all county governments establish an Audit Committee as a best practice and to assist the County Commission in the oversight of the public funds and financial reporting process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hawkins County Commission realizes the need, especially in today's current environment of fewer available resources, for increased transparency and accountability of public funds, and that the County Commission is ultimately responsible for ensuring that management is meeting its internal control and financial reporting responsibilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission finds it to be in the best interests of Hawkins County to establish an Audit Committee;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Commission of Hawkins County, meeting this 27 day of ~~January~~, 2014, that:  
24 February

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to the provisions of T.C.A. § 9-3-405, the County Commission of Hawkins County does hereby establish an Audit Committee to provide independent review and oversight of the county's financial reporting processes and the county's internal controls, a review of the external auditor's report and follow up on management's corrective action, and compliance with laws, regulations, and ethics.

**SECTION 2.** The Audit Committee will consist of five (5) members to be comprised of three (3) County Commissioners from the Budget committee, and two (2) citizens of Hawkins County. To insure the committee's independence and effectiveness, no Audit Committee member will be an elected official (with the exception of elected county commissioners), employee, spouse of an official/employee, or person that commingles assets with an official/employee of Hawkins County. The members of the Audit Committee shall be appointed by the County Commission to staggered two (2) year terms. To establish staggered terms, the initial members of the committee shall be appointed so that the county commissioners serve two (2) year terms and the citizens will serve a one (1) year term. Thereafter all members shall be appointed to serve two (2) year terms.

**SECTION 3.** Meetings of the Audit Committee shall be held in accordance with the provisions of T.C.A. § 9-3-405. Meetings shall be subject to the open meetings provisions of T.C.A. Title 8, Chapter 44, except that upon a majority vote of those members in attendance for the public portion of a meeting, the Audit Committee may hold confidential, nonpublic executive sessions to discuss the following items as authorized in T.C.A. § 9-3-405:

- (1) Items deemed not subject to public inspection under T.C.A. §§ 10-7-503 and 10-7-504, and all other matters designated as confidential or privileged;
- (2) Current or pending litigation and pending legal controversies;
- (3) Pending or ongoing audits or audit related investigations;
- (4) Information protected by federal law; and
- (5) Matters involving the reporting of illegal, improper, wasteful, or fraudulent activity under T.C.A. § 9-3-406, where the informant has requested anonymity.

The Audit Committee will follow Roberts Rules of Order. Each year at its first meeting, the committee will elect a chairman, vice-chairman, and secretary. Meeting agendas will be prepared by the chairman and provided in advance to members along with appropriate briefing materials. Minutes of the Audit Committee meetings will be filed in the Office of the County Mayor and County Clerk.

**SECTION 4.** The committee shall have access to the services of a financial expert, either through a committee member or an outside party engaged by the committee for this purpose. Such financial expert should, through both education and experience, and in a manner specifically relevant to the county government sector, possess (1) an understanding of generally accepted accounting principles and financial statements; (2) experience in preparing or auditing financial statements of comparable entities; (3) experience in applying such principles in connection with the accounting for estimates, accruals, and reserves; (4) experience with internal accounting controls; and (5) an understanding of Audit Committee functions.

**SECTION 5.** The duties and responsibilities of the Audit Committee are:

(a) To carefully review, upon completion of the county's annual audit, all audit findings in audit report and consult with the external auditors regarding any irregularities and deficiencies disclosed in the annual audit. The Audit Committee is empowered to meet with management to discuss audit findings and/or disagreements with the external auditors. The committee should satisfy itself that appropriate and timely corrective action has been taken by management to remedy any identified weaknesses. The committee should determine what corrective action, if any, should be recommended to the County Commission.

(b) To consider the effectiveness of the internal control system, including information technology security and control, review the effectiveness of the system for monitoring compliance with laws and regulations, and review the process for communicating the county's ethics policies to county personnel and monitoring compliance therewith.

(c) To establish a process by which employees, taxpayers, or other citizens may confidentially report suspected illegal, improper, wasteful or fraudulent activity under provisions of T.C.A. § 9-3-406.

(d) To annually present a written committee report detailing how it discharged its duties and any committee recommendations to the full County Commission.

**SECTION 6.** The Audit Committee will be adequately funded to carry out the duties and responsibilities as set out in this Resolution and under applicable law.

**SECTION 7.** This resolution creating the duties and responsibilities of the Audit Committee has been submitted to the Comptroller prior to approval by this legislative body, and this resolution conforms with the report issued by the Comptroller.

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
Hawkins County Tennessee

Organizational Management Group**

This Consulting Agreement is between Hawkins County Tennessee hereinafter referred to as "Client" and Organizational Management Group hereinafter referred to as "Consultant".

In consideration of the mutual promises contained in the Agreement, the Client and Consultant hereby agree as follows:

- 1.0 Retention of Consultant – the Client retains the Consultant and agrees to provide the following services, hereinafter referred to as "Services":
  - 1.1 Providing advice and assistance in developing and maintaining a comprehensive an up-to-date Classification and Compensation Plan.
  - 1.2 Developing up to date job descriptions for each identified job classification.
  - 1.3 Conducting a compensation survey and developing a pay plan for the organization.
- 2.0 Designated Representative – The services will be performed personally by one individual provided by the consultant from time to time, herein designated as Larry Russell, President, OMG, (the "Designated Representative"), who by his execution hereof agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of the Agreement.
- 3.0 Compensation
  - 3.1 For the performance of Services, will pay Consultant a sum not to exceed \$18,800.00 unless otherwise authorized by the Client. This sum will include travel expenses and professional services at the rate of \$100.00/hr. billable on a monthly basis.
  - 3.2 The Client will not have obligation to pay for any services performed or expenses incurred by the Consultant, except as expressly provided in this Agreement, or as otherwise may be agreed upon by the parties in writing prior to the performance of the service or the incurring of the expense.

4.0 Terms of Agreement and Termination

- 4.1 This agreement will be in effect from the date hereof until April 1, 2015 and will continue for successive periods of ninety (90) days each unless terminated by either party or written notice to the other party given not less than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the initial or any renewal term.
- 4.2 Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by written notice.

5.0 Press and Government Communications: Status of Parties

- 5.1 Neither party to this Agreement shall represent the other before any governmental office or body or issue any written or oral statement concerning the other party to any press or any other media organization, unless specifically directed in advance by the affected party.
- 5.2 Nothing in this Agreement shall create the relationship of employer and employee, partnership, principal and agent or joint venture between the Client and Consultant. For the purposes of the Agreement, both parties warrant they are independent contractors, and as such, neither party nor its employees shall have the authority to bind the other party.

6.0 Conflicting Commitments

- 6.1 Both parties represent and warrant that each party's acceptance of the Agreement here under any law or court order, or to any person, corporation, association or other business entity.
- 6.2 Both parties represent and warrant that neither party nor any of its partners, officers, directors or employees have been convicted of a felony or of any crime involving fraud, deceit, theft or dishonesty.
- 6.3 Each party to this agreement agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other party from any claims, demands, costs, judgments, liabilities, losses, attorney's fees and costs resulting from the breach of any warranty in Sections 6.1 and 6.2, above.

7.0 Confidentiality

- 7.1 The Consultant acknowledges a duty of confidentiality owed to the Client and shall not, at any time during or after the terms of this Agreement (except as expressly authorized by the Client in

writing) use, divulge or duplicate any information or copies or records thereof in any medium, which is disclosed to or otherwise obtained by Consultant under or in connection with this Agreement and which is related to the Client and/or its business operations, personnel, finances, income, expenditures, products or services, hereinafter referred to as "Confidential Information".

- 7.2 The consultant acknowledges all such confidential information is a valuable and unique asset of the Client, and that Consultant shall have no rights thereto.
- 7.3 The consultant further agrees to take all necessary precautions to prevent the unauthorized disclosure of such Confidential Information by others.
- 7.4 Upon termination of the Agreement, the Consultant shall deliver to the client, without the necessity of notice or demand all such Confidential Information and copies thereof then in its possession or control.
- 7.5 The terms and conditions of Section 7.1 through 7.4 above, shall survive the expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement, without time limitation.

#### 8.0 Non-Disturbances; Non-Compliance

- 8.1 During the term of this Agreement, both parties to this Agreement agree that neither party shall directly or indirectly disturb any business relationship between either party's employees or customers or own, operate or participate in the ownership or operation of, or in any manner (whether as director, officer, employee, partner, stock holder or consultant) be connected with, any business which is in competition with the Client or the Consultant or any of their respective parent, subsidiary or affiliated entities. The Consultant is free, however, to pursue endeavors not directly associated with Agreement with those agencies, which he/she sees fit to do so.
- 8.2 The terms and conditions of Section 8.1 above shall survive the expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement.

#### 9.0 Miscellaneous

- 9.1 Any notice given under this Agreement shall be in writing and deemed given when sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to a party at its address set forth on the first page of this Agreement



or to such other address as hereafter may be specified by like notice given such party.

- 9.2 This Agreement contains the entire understanding and agreement of the parties, superseding all prior understandings and agreements, with respect to its subject matter.
- 9.3 If any part of this Agreement is determined to be unenforceable, the remainder may still be enforced. Both parties agree that the restricted covenants set forth in this Agreement are reasonable and necessary to protect the business interests of both parties. If any such restriction is determined to be overly broad, it is to be interpreted as limited in duration or scope to the extent necessary to render it enforceable.
- 9.4 This Agreement may not be modified except in writing signed by both parties.
- 9.5 No waiver of any provisions of this Agreement will be effective unless agreed to in writing by the party against whom such waiver is sought to be enforced. Waiver of any breach or default of this Agreement will not constitute a waiver of subsequent or other breach or default of this Agreement, whether similar or otherwise.
- 9.6 Section headings are for convenience only and are not to be considered in the construction or interpretation of any provisions of this Agreement.
- 9.7 This Agreement will bind and insure to the benefit of the parties and their respective heirs, successors, legal representative and permitted assigns. This Agreement may be assigned by either party to any of its parent, subsidiary or affiliated entities or to any successor interest, by purchase, merger or otherwise, to any of the foregoing only upon the written consent of the affected party.
- 9.8 Both parties agree that in addition to any legal or equitable remedies, either party will be entitled to a temporary restraining order, injunction or other appropriate court order to prohibit actual or threatened breach of this Agreement.
- 9.9 The validity, interpretation and enforceability of this Agreement will be governed by Tennessee law.
