To the HONORABLE MELVILLE BAILEY, Chairman, and Members of the Hawkins County Board of Commission in Regular Session, met this 26th day of September, 2011.

RESOLUTION IN REF: TO ADOPT A REAPPORTIONMENT/REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR HAWKINS COUNTY

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-111, requires that, at least every ten (10) years, county legislative bodies shall change the boundaries of districts or redistrict a county entirely if necessary to apportion the county legislative body so that the members represent substantially equal populations; and

WHEREAS, Hawkins County has prepared a plan consistent with the provisions of *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-111, which provides for a county legislative body composed of 21 members and which creates 7 districts as depicted on the official redistricting map for Hawkins County prepared pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-110.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hawkins County Legislative Body meeting in Regular session at Rogersville, Tennessee, on this 26th day of September, 2011, that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby adopted a reapportionment plan for Hawkins County which provides for the following:

Seven Districts each having:

1. Three (3) commissioners in each district for a total county legislative body of (21) Twenty-one members
2. Seven (7) School Board members (1 per district)
3. Seven (7) Constables (1 per district)

The districts for members of the county legislative body, school board and constables are depicted on the official redistricting map for Hawkins County prepared pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-110. A copy of the redistricting map and plan is attached as Exhibit A to this resolution and is incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. All members of the county legislative body shall be elected at large within the district wherein the candidate seeks election. The (3) three candidates receiving the greatest number of votes in each district shall be elected. All school board members and constables shall be elected at large wherein the candidate seeks election. The candidate receiving the greatest number of votes in each district shall be elected.

SECTION 3. This plan shall take effect upon passage, the public welfare requiring it, provided that vacancies shall be filed in accordance with *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-104.

1. Seven (7) Districts
2. Three (3) Commissioners per district
TOTAL Twenty One (21) Commissioners
3. Seven (7) School Board Members – (1) per district
4. Seven (7) Constables – (1) per district

The only change from the previous 2001 Re-Districting Plan to the 2011 Plan is as follows:

1. Moving 112 people from District 2 into District 3
